Maritime transport is the principal means of transportation in international trade, allowing massive quantities of goods to be shipped at very economical costs. However, adapting port infrastructure to new ship sizes, the capacity requirements of world maritime trade and the subsequent logistical needs for Latin American countries, imply an overall investment -purely in terms of new port infrastructure for containers- of around US \$47,000 million up until 2040. The foregoing reveals a large potential market for new business and enormous business opportunities for sector suppliers, as well as huge challenges for both the public and private sectors, in terms of updating regulations and facilitating the corresponding investment flows within these frameworks.
